

The East Side Streets Coalition

Our Coalition is the first community-driven East Side organizing initiative aimed at reducing vehicle crashes and improving pedestrian, bicyclist and transit rider safety. Our goal is to reduce pedestrian and cyclist injuries and fatalities on the East Side by 50% over the next ten years.

Transportation Alternatives has been working with the Coalition to develop an East Side Action Plan. The plan will be based on feedback shared at six community workshops that took place during the spring 2010 and will recommend design changes to make streets safer. It will also illustrate how people use their streets and explain how the built environment can better support walking, biking and riding public transportation. The Coalition will focus on carrying out the Action Plan.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A COALITION MEMBER?

The Coalition is focused on carrying out the East Side Action Plan. Joining the Coalition is an exciting opportunity to make the East Side safer for the millions who live, work and visit each year.
